(6) Einstein proved that gravity actually curved the fabric of space. (7) Even more interestingly, he showed that "time" itself was not constant. (8) He showed that "time" is slowed down as an object's speed approaches the speed of light. (9) By the time he was 40, he was world famous
- (10) Later in life, Einstein became famous for encouraging the United States to develop an atomic bomb. (11) Einstein moved to America when Hitler began persecuting Jews in Germany. (12) Germany and America were at war, and Einstein knew that Germany was trying to invent an atomic bomb. (13) Horrified by this prospect, he wrote a letter to President Roosevelt telling him that bombs of incredible power could be made by splitting atoms. (14) The American effort to develop the bomb was successful, and it brought an early end to World War II. (15) However, Einstein was so sickened by the destructive power of the atom bomb that he spent the rest of his life looking for peaceful uses for atomic energy.
